- Permanent patios continue for April 1, 2023
- Development updates:
 - 90 Carling St (backs on King property near Food Basics) Construction moving along
 - McMaster residence. Demolition complete. Residence expected to be completed for September 2025.
 - o 804-816 King St W (@ Paradise) 6-storey. Approved by the City and ready to proceed.
- Snow sidewalk clearing starts DEC 2022
 - confirmation on all Westdale Village King St W sidewalks yes for sidewalks in BIA on King St W and Sterling – along bus route, including parkettes by Theatre and Pace
- Westdale construction 2023:
 - Marion Ave S resurfacing
 - Marion Ave N full reconstruction
