A: City of Hamilton: regrets from Councillor Maureen Wilson

- Permanent patios continue for April 1, 2023. Requesting that City continue to support patios permit fees continuing from 2022 with funds already approved.
- Development updates:
 - o 90 Carling St (backs on King property near Food Basics) Construction moving along
 - McMaster residence. Demolition complete. Residence expected to be completed for September 2025.
 - 804-816 King St W (@ Paradise) 6-storey. Approved by the City and ready to proceed.
- Snow sidewalk clearing starts DEC 2022
 - confirmation on all Westdale Village King St W sidewalks yes for sidewalks in BIA on King St W and Sterling – along bus route, including parkettes by Theatre and Pace
- Westdale construction 2023:
 - Marion Ave S resurfacing
 - Marion Ave N full reconstruction
 - Resurfacing Cline Ave S King to Sterling, Whitton Rd, Oakwood Pl
 - Sterling Sewer chamber work between Oakwood Pl and Forsyth
 - Sterling resurfacing King to Forsyth
- Churchill Hill Park Phase 2 construction park being used much more
- LRT some buildings torn down. Reminder request King 1 bus to remain through Westdale Village and request for another LRT stop needed between Longwood and Cootes.

B: Financial Update (Anita, Tracy):

- Bank Balance as of January 31, 2023 is \$917.96 (JAN statement not yet received by mail)
- Please note: ~\$24 000 in 2023 expenditures came out in January before 2023 levy received, \$28 000 + \$1 000 in grants from 2022 expenditures to come in February.
- A number of receivables and payables to happen in January/February.

- First have of levy \$64 062.50 to come in early February.
- HST 2020 and 2021 ~\$10000 to come in 2023
- Working to finalize things for audit and bring things up to date.

- Special programming (Hamilton Originals, film talks) continues
- Private rentals bringing in revenue

- Working on reaching new arts and awareness for funding needs

D: Safety and Security (Anita, Tracy):

- Update on ATM issues (all ATMs now being locked overnight)
- Crime update: no reported crime since January meeting (one planter). Mikels break in and robbery not showing as reported.

E: Real Estate update (Tracy):

- Commercial 1 spot for lease now, sign down the back up beside Dragon Court
- Residential more families transforming student houses, pricing lowered, but not by as much in other areas of Hamilton. Westdale a desirable place to live.

F: HPL update (Ron):

- General update: still not back to same level of programming, but moving closer.
- Getting busier all the time, lots of after school, programming increasing, partnership green venture, seed venture was very successful.

G: Business updates (Tracy):

- More renovations at UPS building a couple more food places expected to open soon, building painted, new signs coming, Basilique sold now being renovated
- Building where fire was beside Dragon Court renos seem mostly complete.
- Monga Fried Chicken now open 1050 King St menu board, soft opening yesterday, a chain with one in Mississauga
- Retail artists shop to open sometime after renos at 948 King St new front windows & doors
- Former Pete and Kay location upstairs residential main floor expected to be a restaurant, but not yet listed for lease. BIA has received some inquiries and connected.
- Digital Main Street grant now open 2023 \$2500, free google 360 photo tours for businesses
 Small business centre organizing only about 10 minutes to get done
