- Development updates:
 - 90 Carling St (backs on King property near Food Basics) almost complete, move in
 - McMaster residence. Demolition complete. Residence expected to be completed for September 2025. Project moving along. Lots of construction activity
 - o 804-816 King St W (@ Paradise) 6-storey. Approved but nothing submitted to start
- Westdale LRT construction:
 - LRT some buildings torn down. Westdale BIA requests King 1 bus to remain through Westdale Village and request for another LRT stop needed between Longwood and Cootes.
- 2 way Main Street and King Street update changes coming in 2025/2026 with long overdue upgrades to be incorporated, 2025 or 2026
- Crosswalk at King @ Paisley. Green Venture sending plan to look like much of what we did at the clock across the street, with a request for some bolders.
